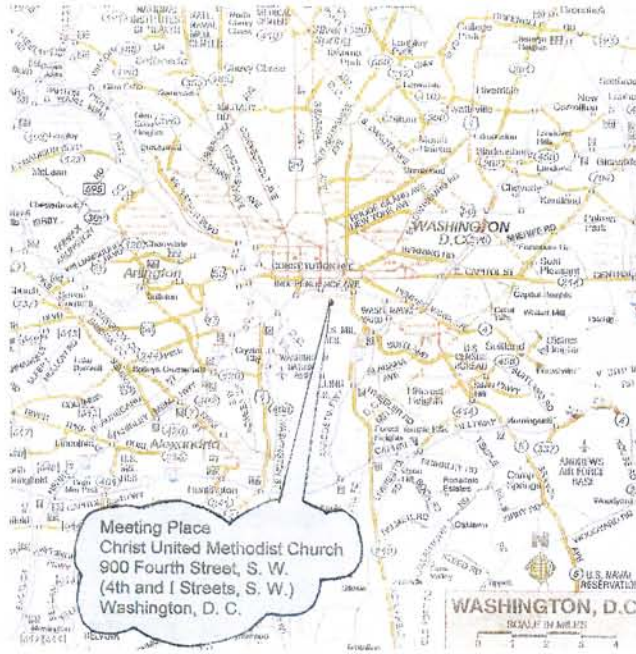

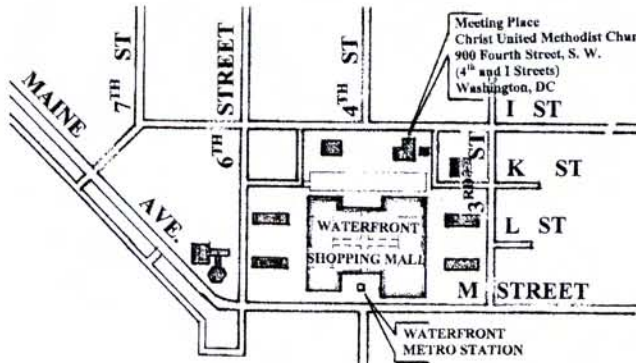

The **Washington Stamp Collectors Club** (WSCC) was formed on January 1, 2006, through a merger of the Collectors Club of Washington (1927) and the Washington Philatelic Society (1905), to foster philatelic enjoyment and educational benefits to stamp collectors in the Washington, DC area. The WSCC provides a wide variety of activities for the stamp collector, including trading and selling stamps, buying stamps, regular programs of interest to the novice and advanced collector, six auctions annually, two different U.S. and worldwide stamp circuits at each meeting, a WSCC Newsletter published six times a year, and many other activities.

The WSCC is engaged in a variety of activities of interest to the stamp collector. Meetings are held twice monthly, all year round. The meeting location is in Southwest Washington, near the waterfront and a short distance from the Waterfront Metrorail station. The meetings include selling, buying, trading, and talking about stamps. An auction is held every two months, where stamps, covers, and philatelic literature are

bought and sold. Meetings also feature frequent member and guest presentations, the availability of two approval circuits (including APS), philatelic quizzes, contests (with real prize money), our popular Holiday Auction and Party, a annual Awards Banquet, and more. Refreshments are available at each meeting.

A First Day Cover program is also maintained by the club. Selected new issues are chosen and special cachets are created. First day cancellations are obtained and the covers are sold to members at a small increase over cost.

Our bi-monthly newsletter, *WASHINGTON CITY DESPATCH*, lists the upcoming programs, club shows in the DC area and nearby World Series of Philately exhibitions; as well as articles on District of Columbia Postal History, interesting stories of philatelic interest and news of members.

The WSCC has six classes of membership; Regular, Life, Non-resident Regular, Non-resident Life, Junior, and Honorary. A Junior member is defined as any member younger than 18 years old. A Non-resident Regular member is defined as a member who does not reside permanently in the Washington, DC metropolitan area and normally cannot attend meetings due to geographic distance. The membership year is July 1 through June 30. Regular membership dues are \$16.00 annually; Non-resident Regular and Junior membership dues are \$8.00 annually. For Life membership fees, contact the Executive Secretary.

WSCC is a member of the American Philatelic Society (Life Chapter 18), American Topical Association (Chapter 55), and the Virginia Philatelic Federation.
